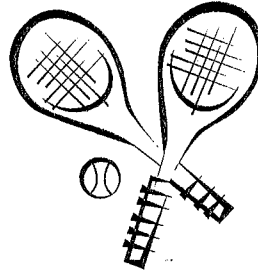

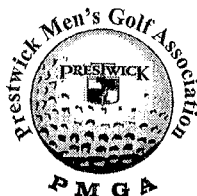

## GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE



With April upon us, it is time to start looking towards our summer golf course maintenance. We are still going to be very busy keeping the course manicured for the spring golfers, but it is time to get a head start on our summer time tasks as well. Our biggest agronomic

challenge in the summer is weed control. We usually start preliminary weed control applications in mid-March and step up the intensity of our efforts progressively through late spring until summer arrives. Then weed control becomes an all day, every day initiative. Because of Prestwick's mounds and steep faces in many area it is impossible to apply pesticides with a conventional boom type sprayer. Instead, it is necessary to use backpack sprayers and the handgun attachment on our regular sprayer, both of which are very time consuming compared to a conventional boom type sprayer. Because this past winter was somewhat mild, the weeds seem to have over wintered quite well and appear to be that much more prevalent already. An early start on weed control this spring should pay off this summer with very weed free turf.

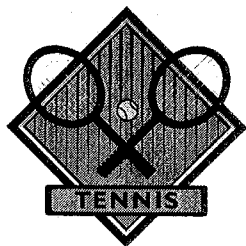

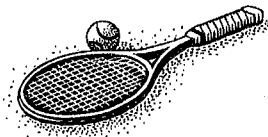

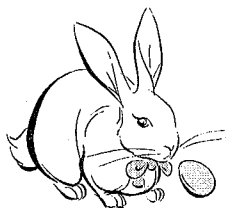

### Interclub Doubles Team Tennis

Each team will consist of 6 players:

- 2-3.0's, 2-3.5's, 2-4.0's
- Both Men and Women's divisions will be formed. (men play men, women play women)
- Players will be drafted by appointed captains at Player Party.
- If you are interested in being a team captain contact Mike Saless at 828-1000.
- Draft order will be determined at party.
- Each team then will compete with other teams at scheduled times.
- A schedule will be generated at the end of draft. A time will be set for each match but captains may have all week to re-schedule their match by positions if both captains agree. This schedule will be flexible due to the players also playing spring matches.
- Each match will consist of three doubles positions: 1, 2 and 3.
  1. Captains must set their lineups in the following order:
    1. 4.0's play #1 position
    2. 3.5's play #2 position
    3. 3.0's play #3 position
- A match is won when a team wins 2 out of three positions. Each match will consist of 2 out of 3 sets. The 10 pt. tie-breaker will be lieu of third set.
- Cost is \$20.00 a player. Winners from each division will receive a percentage of prize money. There will also be an end of year play off system for the remaining prize money.
  - Balls will be included for each match.
- Alternate players may be added to a team if injuries occur and an alternate player list (players not drafted) will be used if you can't field a team.



### Taking Control of the Point

**Beginner:** Keep it deep and attack the net on short balls.  
**Intermediate:** Vary the height and spin of the ball and take the ball on the rise.  
**Advanced:** Hit behind your opponent and use short angles.
