Golf Course Maintenance

As I write this article it is mid-January, but it sure doesn't feel like it outside. It is warm for this time of year and it seems we have been having these warm spells off and on throughout the late fall and into the winter. Although these warm temperatures are certainly nice for golf and help our course overseeding gain some maturity a bit early, they sometimes bring about some unique challenges. The main detrimental aspect of these unseasonably warm temperatures is the danger that a prolonged period of these warmer temperatures can begin to bring the bermudagrass partially out of dormancy. This is not such a big deal in April, but in January it can result in significant damage to the bermudagrass if the warm periods persist and are immediately followed by an extended period under 30 degrees. Hopefully this scenario will not play out, but if it does it will not become apparent until late spring.

Overall I am very pleased with the overseeding, as well as, the overall course conditions. Throughout the remainder of the winter we will continue to make improvements and fine-tune the

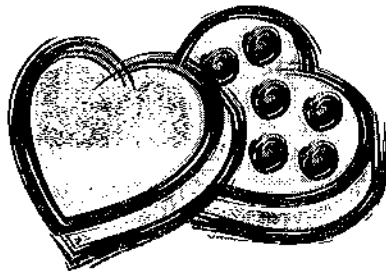
