In closing, I want to thank the membership for your support during 2006. Your support truly helped us to have a successful year.

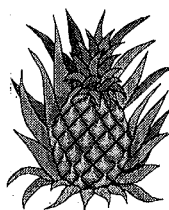

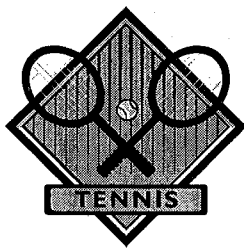
TENNIS AND SWIM NEWS

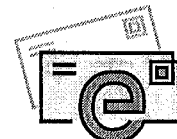

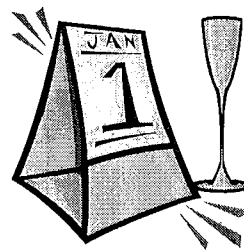
