GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE



Busy, busy, busy is how I would describe June and July. We are right in the middle of a tee expansion project on holes #1, 2, 9 and 18. The tees on #1 and 2 are very close to being returned to playing status and the tees on #9 and 18 will be a few weeks later. The tee project, albeit hectic, will no doubt result in much better tee quality on these holes.

As I indicated in last month's article the turf on many holes was damaged by the cold weather this past Easter. We also have been very busy stripping these areas out and replacing them with fresh sod.

Many of our turf areas have been tested for and diagnosed with unacceptable levels of nematodes. Nematodes are microscopic worms that feed on plant roots. Once the nematodes reach a certain level they damage the roots of turfgrass to a point where they no longer respond to fertilizer and irrigation. Once at this point the turf thins to bare dirt. On many of our holes we have reached this advanced stage of damage. By the time everyone reads this we will have had an outside company come in and treat approximately 20 acres for nematodes. Unfortunately, the chemical is quite toxic so we will be forced to close down to make the application. The good news is that the treatment is very effective.

Although it has been quite hectic working through these projects, it is exciting to know that we will have made all these course improvements that will benefit us for years to come.
