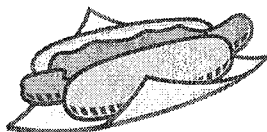

As always, please feel free to call me or come by anytime.

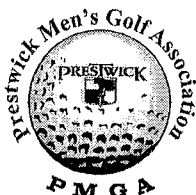

GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE



While I write this article I am wondering to myself if it is ever going to rain again. During this dry spell it would have been real easy for myself, as well as, our maintenance team to feel a bit depressed because we have an aging irrigation system that has proved quite challenging at times to maintain, but instead we decided to view this as an opportunity, an opportunity to really identify the inefficiencies of our irrigation system and target them for systematic improvements.

During the transition from overseeded grass to our base of bermudagrass we have recognized another problem that we will need to deal with. We are seeing large areas of winterkill, most likely from the major fluctuations in temperature and precipitation throughout the fall, winter and spring. In my opinion the most damaging temperature change came around Easter. The bermudagrass was already greening up quite well and then we got that harsh cold blast that dropped the night time temperatures into the mid 20's for several days. I can't recall another time when plants such as crepe myrtles were shocked so bad by cold weather that it killed their new foliage. The process for healing the turf in these winterkill areas will be time, fertilizer, water and in many spots sod. Please bear with us while we work to return the course to the type of conditions we all expect.

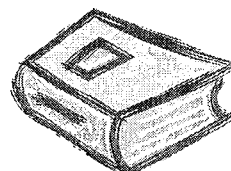


Congratulations to the Prestwick 4.0 Men's Team! They finished 2nd in the State playoffs that were held in Charleston May 19th - 21st.
