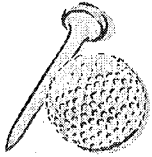

Happy Halloween! Cooler weather has finally arrived along with the overseeding process. The course has been in great shape and should continue.

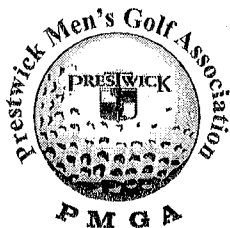
Our annual Member-Guest Tournament was held August 30th, 31st and September 1st. Congratulations to all the winners and to those that played. Thank you for a wonderful event.

GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE

October is a big month for changes. During October we usually get our first taste of jacket weather, we begin to get a bit of relief on our roads with the summertime tourists returning to their homes and finally with the start of football season there is something decent to watch on TV. On the golf course October brings probably the greatest change of all, the overseeding of the course.

We will begin overseeding the greens on October 1st and 2nd. The process will involve verticutting the greens fairly aggressively in two directions, applying a pre-plant fertilizer, seeding the greens and adding a light coating of topdressing sand. We will be frequently watering the greens throughout the course of the month to get the seed up and then we will continue irrigating frequently until the young overseeded grass develops a root system where it can begin to stand on its own.

This year, as I mentioned in last month's article, we will be overseeding wall to wall. Much of the process will take place during the early morning hours and late at night as well. We are restricted to these hours obviously because of the presence of golfers during the day, but also because the dew plays a critical role allowing us to make sure we cover everything, but not over apply the seed.

One difference this year will be that we will not have to restrict carts to the paths to avoid spreading the seed to unoverseeded areas, but once the seed begins to germinate we will be forced to remain on the cartpaths for a few days to allow the seed to develop in heavier traffic areas.

This whole process should be completed by October 15th and as always we appreciate everyone's patience throughout this process.

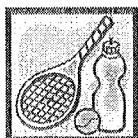

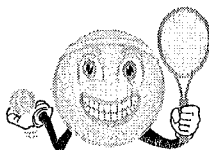

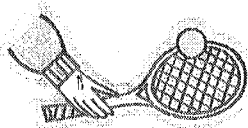
