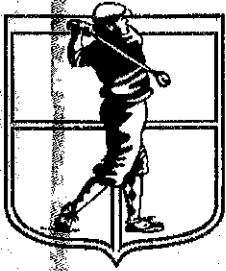

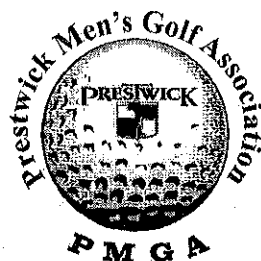

GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE

After a long hot summer it is very nice to start to feel the cooler weather of fall. With the cooler weather comes our last big maintenance task of the year, overseeding. We will again be overseeding the greens, tees and fairways only. If the weather cooperates we should have all those areas seeded by the end of the first week of October. As in the past we will restrict carts to the paths in the mornings until the dew lifts, so we do not track seed out into the unoverseeded rough. We will also allow the newly seeded ryegrass to grow up a bit prior to the first cutting to allow greater establishment. We appreciate everyone's cooperation during our transition.

On a separate note, I would like to give everyone an update on the injured swan. After the maintenance staff captured the injured bird, it was taken to Ark Animal Hospital to be treated for its injuries. Once they feel the bird has recovered, they hope to return it to Prestwick.

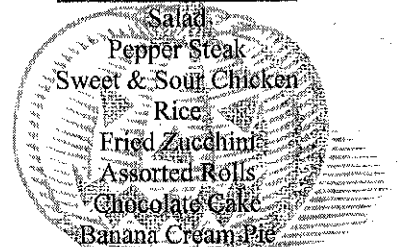
