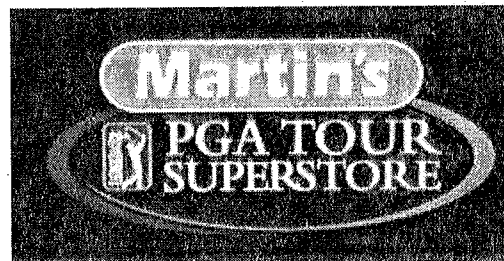
A Message to Prestwick Members

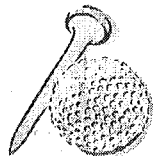

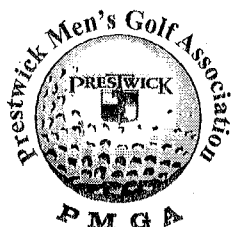

GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE

As the summer of 2007 draws to a close, it will be etched in my mind as one of the hottest and driest of my career. Now we move forward into my personal favorite season, fall. The demands of aggressively growing bermudagrass begin to ease and we can now focus on overseeding of the course. The process of overseeding brings about a fairly rapid transformation of the course from the somewhat dull green of bermudagrass to the vibrant, deep green of ryegrass. Even after all these years I still thoroughly enjoy seeing the overseed begin to germinate. This year I am particularly excited because the company has shown even more commitment to the quality of the course conditions by providing us with substantially more resources, which will allow us to oversee the course wall to wall. This commitment goes well beyond the cost of additional seed, although it is significant. The decision to oversee wall to wall requires more ongoing manpower for mowing, as well as, larger amounts of fertilizer and chemicals through fall, winter and spring. I believe strongly that the enhanced course conditions will speak for themselves.

As far as the actual overseeding process itself goes, it will take substantially longer. Those of you that live around the course, please do not be alarmed if you see equipment operating after dark or a bit earlier in the morning. When all is said and done we will end up spreading about 40,000 lbs. of seed. The process will begin on the 1st of October and will continue until we are finished, which could end up being until the 15th depending on the weather.

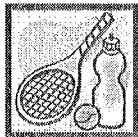
