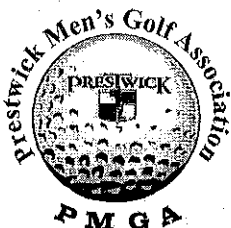

GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE



By the time everyone reads this the greens should be healed nicely from the aeration. The fairway and tees should show little if any evidence of their recent dethatching. We will be overseeding the course the first part of October. In preparation of the overseeding we will be gradually raising the mowing height on the greens to give them some relief prior to the onset of cooler weather. We got pretty aggressive with the greens prior to the Member Guest tournament with some lower heights of cut than normal and some high rate growth regulator applications. The result has been greens that roll faster than normal, but the growth regulator also tends to keep the greens off color for a bit until it grows out of it. We will continue to use these products from time to time in the future. They are a great tool to tighten up the bermudagrass on the greens and enable us to get them rolling faster than we normally would be able to with standard cultural practices.

During September we will also be continuing to prepare the course for the busy golf season. With the growth of the grass beginning to slow it will enable us to focus our efforts in other areas besides grass cutting.

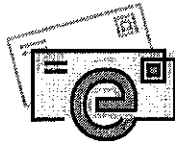
